Congratulations to Dr. Halfan Said Ngowo for successfully passing his PhD at the University of Glasgow, UK. For the past four years, Dr. Ngowo worked tirelessly on his thesis titled: Quantitative Ecology of the Malaria Vector, *Anopheles funestus*.

The core of Dr. Ngowo's PhD was the development and testing of Bayesian state space models to understand the natural population dynamics of malaria vectors (see an example:
